Open Settings

Tap the gray gear icon on your home screen

2

Tap Display & Brightness

Scroll down — it's near the top of the list

3

Slide Text Size to the right

Stop when the preview text feels comfortable



Android

Samsung, Google, etc.

Open Settings

Tap the gear icon — or swipe down and tap the gear

2

Tap Display

May also say "Display & Brightness" or "Screen"

3

Tap Font Size & drag right

Stop when the preview text feels comfortable



Computer

Windows or Mac

1

Find the Ctrl key

Bottom-left of your keyboard (Mac: use Cmd ⌘ instead)

2

Hold Ctrl and press +

Each press makes everything on screen 10% bigger

3

Stop when it feels right

To go back: hold Ctrl and press – (minus)

Bonus tip — turn on Bold Text: On iPhone or Android, go to Settings → Accessibility → Display & Text Size → turn on **Bold Text**. Everything gets sharper and easier to read instantly.
